**Lake lines:** We have had good numbers caught in all our lakes. Many of you have missed our spring bite. Top water has been good and of course, plastics. When worm fishing, try to keep the bait on the bottom as much as possible. Remember, that big bass normally will not move far to chase a worm. If you work your bait fast, like many anglers do, you will get more little bites, and the big bass probably won't bite. Remember, the most common topwater fishing mistakes are: setting the hook too soon; too short of cast; fishing topwaters at the wrong time; and fishing the wrong water. Topwater fishing is best at dusk, dawn, and on cloudy days when the water temp is over 60 degrees. So bring your family and friends and come catch your next trophy bass
